For the period 2022 to 2023, the Department for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs (Defra) has committed £1.7m to support core network activity in support of rural community projects, encourage shared learning between members and access to local intelligence.

Nature of the Work

ACRE is looking to appoint a consultant to work with us to analyse information provided by our members in quarterly surveys and produce four performance reports that will be presented to ACRE and Defra, utilising information covering the period 1 April 2022 to 31 March 2023.

The work will begin on the **1 May 2022** and should be completed by **30 June 2023**.
